



Information on the Master Class at Nuremberg University of Music

Aim of the course of study

The four-semester master class course allows exceptionally well-qualified students to consolidate and perfect the skills they acquired in a previous course of study, and ends with the master class diploma.

The diploma verifies that the student has the technical and artistic ability to particularly meet the requirements in public concert life as a soloist or chamber musician.

Admission requirements

To qualify for the master class, you must have a university degree from a German or non-German university in the major subject for which you are applying. You must have achieved the highest possible grade in the subject in which you majored. Particular artistic excellence must also be verified by a letter of recommendation from the tutor who is to teach the major subject in the master class course at Nuremberg University of Music (see §2, Paragraph 6 of the rules governing qualification requirements ("QualS")). A table outlining the artistic path of education and study must also be submitted.

Foreign applicants must submit a certificate verifying knowledge of German to CEFR level B1.
